

**SGCS Booster Meeting Minutes**  
**June 1, 2006**

Secretary's report: Reading of the minutes was waived. These are posted on the website. No changes were noted.

Treasurer's Report: Tony had copies of the transactions from March 14, 2006 to May 31, 2006. Net expense for the banquet was approximately \$900. Profit from the flower sale was \$1009.00. \$544 worth of spirit wear was sold at Funfest. The \$2000 PTO donation was made for this year. This will decrease by \$500 in the coming years. Tony will ask the PTO officers if there is a better time of year for that organization to make their donation. \$This year we have had \$41,000 in/out of our checking account.

Joe mentioned that he was approached by Patty K. with the idea of a golf outing at Glenview as a fundraiser for the school. Rich C. stated that he would talk to her and see if she would be interested in doing this for Boosters. We talked about possibly an October date.

We also discussed sales at Riverfront as a fundraiser and it was decided that it was a lot of work with little guarantee. It was mentioned that some schools have been seen manning beer booths at XU basketball games. We will look into that as another possible fundraiser.

Registrations: Tony reported that we had 39 girls register for basketball for the fall season. This is down from last year when we had 57. Some of those not registered are historically late. Tony will contact those who have played in the past and the incoming third graders.

No girls signed up for cheerleading for the coming year.

Coordinators: Mark G. will be meeting with Tony in July to plan for the upcoming boys' basketball season.

Wendy W. and Brenda T. are in the midst of planning the girls' season.

Spring Season Update: The fourth grade boys' baseball team lost in the semi-finals of the City Championship. They were 6-3 for the season.

The fifth grade girls' softball team won the City Championship for the second year in a row.

We are in need of a softball/baseball coordinator for next year. Also it would be good if we could condition the field in the fall so it is ready for next year. George stated at the last meeting that we should let him know what needs to be done and he will see if he can take care of it.

Cheerleading: Celeste T. presented a write up of cheerleading information to be passed on to future coordinators to help with the running of the program. She stated there was some difficulty with conflicts over volleyball and other school events. Assumption's cheer coordinator will have information on cheerleading camps and clinics.

Uniforms: Patty stated that we are missing one set of new uniforms from a girl who left the school. We have 19 basketballs of the size the girls use. Patty still needs to get the volleyball equipment. The storage area is getting full.

Joe will email the Archdiocese to see if any school is in need of our old volleyball uniforms.

We hope to have a designated uniform pick up day before the fall basketball season starts for parents to attend with their child. Parents will sign a form stating they are responsible for returning it at the end of the season or paying for it.
