Secretary's Report: The reading of the minutes from last meeting was waived as they are on the school website. A copy was passed for those interested in viewing them.

Treasurer's Report: Tony L. reported that we have \$13637.65 in the bank at this time. The bulk of this is income from winter sport sign-ups. We have paid for new equipment for volleyball and a coach's clinic. We have spent over \$4500 in new uniforms in the last two years.

Fundraisers:

Spirit wear- \$1500 profit since July 1, 2006. Thank you to Kelli W. for a great job.

Max & Erma's- \$168.84 This is down from last year. Maybe people are tired of this event. Possibly check into Cici's pizza or Applebees's.

Buddy Cards - \$300 profit We still have about 20 cards to sell.

Girls Basketball:

Wendy W. gave a report. All teams are now done in the CYO tournament. Most of the uniforms and equipment has been collected. Pictures were taken this evening at school. Not all teams participated in the picture taking. We are still looking for a few dates of gate receipts.

The coordinators will contact the coaches and have them get the parent survey off of the website to distribute to their team. The parents should return the completed surveys to Rich C.

Wendy stated that we need to develop a procedure to select an A coach if we have more than one person volunteering for that position.

Wendy also stated that we need to get the coordinators the information shortly after registration is done in May. Tryouts will be needed next year for an A and B team. The coordinators will try and schedule them early, possibly even before school is out.

Tony thanked Wendy and Brenda on behalf of the board for all their work this year. Brenda T. and Wendy W. volunteered to be coordinators for next year.

Boys Football Results

Girls Volleyball:

Karin Z. was not present but Tony reported that we have 8 teams registered. Practice times have been solidified with each team having two times per week.

We have no information from George on his conversations with people at Mercy about the status of St. Francis.

Spring Sports:

Spring signups will be the first two weeks in January. We plan on sending a reminder out after Thanksgiving and a reminder in January. Also included will be an explanation of late registration rules (additional cost and no guarantee of placement on a team)

Neal McD. is hoping to have a 4th grade baseball team to join the 5th grade team. We are unsure of the status of the 6th grade softball team.

We need a baseball/softball coordinator.

Fr. Fay approved placing good quality dirt on the field. Rich C. will try to get this done soon.
